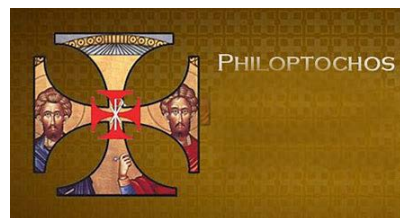
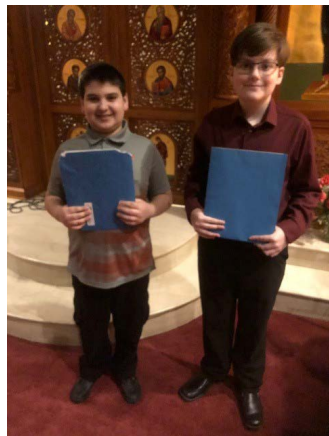

Philoptochos

We thank you all for your support and generous donations.

With all of your help, we were able to meet the National Philoptochos obligations, after which we received a certificate of Excellence for meeting the 2019 National Obligations.

1. We donated to the Hurricane Relief Fund, to the Attica Relief Fund (for the fires in Greece).
2. Thanksgiving: we donated food to 43 families through the Rockland Social Services. We made a monetary donation to People to People.
3. Christmas: we adopted a family of five, through the United Way.
4. We also donated to the Ronald McDonald's House Greek Division for children who have cancer.
5. We donated to the Archangel Michael Nursing Home in Yonkers.
6. Through the District Archdiocese Philoptochos, we helped families who needed assistance for medical and funeral expenses.
7. We treated the children from Saint Basil's Academy, who came to our Festival for lunch and visitation.

Last October, our Philoptochos started knitting and crocheting club. We knitted and crocheted hats, sweaters and small afghans for babies, which we donated to Birthright in Nanuet which is an organization that helps unwed mothers who want to keep their babies.

On June 1st, we attended the Saint Basil's Academy graduation and we donated sweaters, hats, and scarves that we knitted and crocheted for the twenty-one children who were there.

On May 18th, we attended the DAD Conference where we received an Award of Excellence for an increase in membership.

We have three young ladies on our Board: Cleo Maranski who is our recording secretary; Faye Butera and Connie Francanbandera as treasurers and Assistant Treasurer. Someday, these young ladies will take over Philoptochos as presidents.

I wish to thank all the ladies on the Board and Philoptochos members for all their help and dedication throughout the year, in cooking

and preparing for our fund raising luncheons, setting up for the coffee hours, dying eggs for Easter, decoration of the Koubouklion on Good Friday, baking prosfora, and cooking and baking and chopping vegetables for the festival and for all the other obligations we have.
